Robin shared the Playground Committee information package describing the need and incentives for large donations from businesses. Looking for volunteers to reach out to businesses for interest as well as reaching out to local media to encourage donations. A video needs to be created for McDougall insurance donation, this would hopefully be created by students.

# 7:00 pm Regional Council Update - Caitlin and Robin

No additional information was provided on HST rebates

There was a presentation on the nutrition program, describing where the funding comes from, each school runs their own program so they each are individualized.

French Immersion program is being extended across the board and is being added in Campbellford and Northumberland.

The board has hired Mental Health Clinicians running groups for upper year students. Kaawaate has been asked to be a pilot school for one of the programs. 36 students. and basically the only solution is larger class sizes for next year. I think maybe we all knew that, but it was actually said.

Potential for a 50/50 fundraiser or a lemonade or bake sale as additional fundraiser options at the yard sale. Chantal and Erin will look into facilitating and organizing this.
